The Kopul HDMISW51H20 switches between five HDMI 2.0 sources and outputs the signal to an HD monitor or HDTV set. The switcher supports resolutions up to 4K @ 60 Hz, and it's HDCP 2.2 compliant for the latest streaming and Blu-ray formats.

With plug-and-play simplicity, no special cables or software are needed. Plug the switcher into an outlet, make the HDMI connections, and it's ready to send multiple signals to your monitor.

Precautions

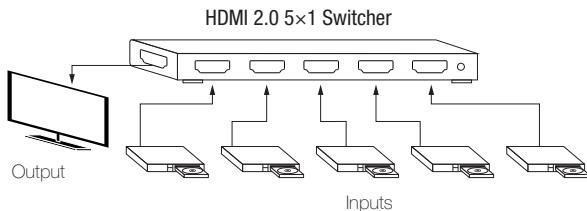
- Please read and follow these instructions, and keep this manual in a safe place.

Setting Up

1. Connect the switcher to an AC outlet with the included power cable.
2. Use HDMI cables to connect up to five signal sources to the switcher's input ports.
3. Use an HDMI cable to connect a TV or monitor to the switcher's output port.



Using the Remote Control

1. Press the battery release, and remove the battery tray.
2. Insert the battery into the tray, making sure the side marked with a plus sign (+) is facing up.
3. Push the battery tray back into the remote so it locks in place.

Note: Use the included remote control to wirelessly select the signal source of the HDMI switcher. Before using the remote control for the first time, you will need to install a CR2025 3V lithium battery.

Selecting an Input Signal

To cycle through the signal sources, repeatedly press the selector button on the top of the switcher, or press the  button on the remote.

To select a specific signal source, press the corresponding numbered button on the remote (1–5).
